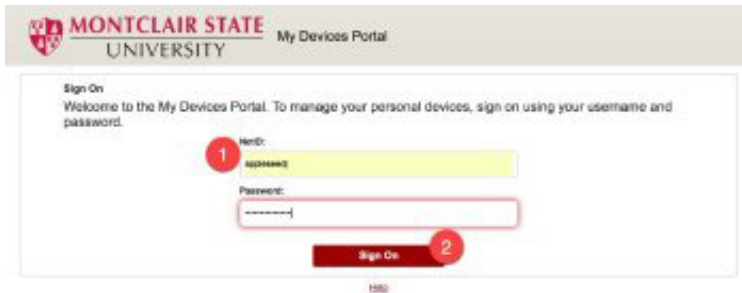

Delete a device

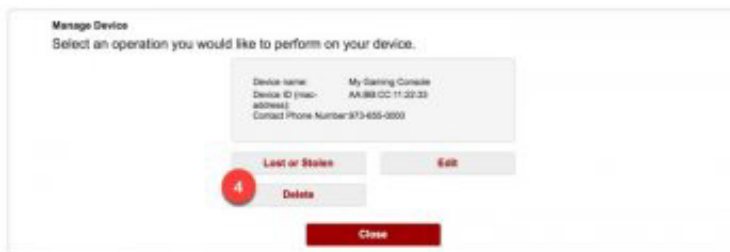

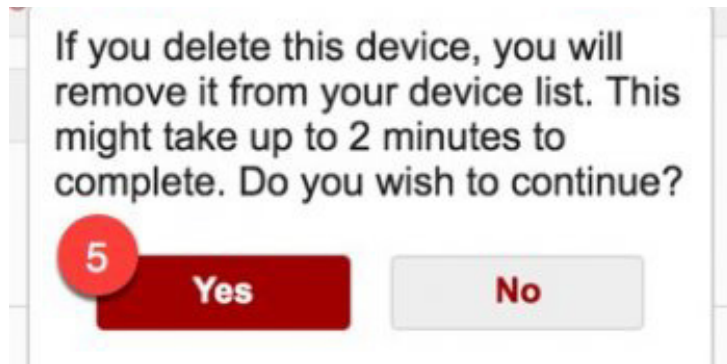
